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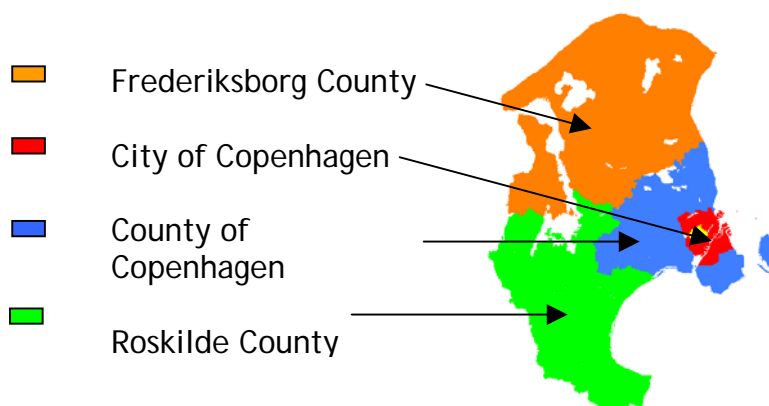

The data below include various numbers such as bed nights, capacity and bed occupancy etc. for hotels, guesthouses, motels, inns and holiday centers in Greater Copenhagen (with at least 40 beds).

- The bed night numbers are assessed as the number of guests multiplied by the number of nights stayed. Extra beds are included.
- Room capacity is assessed as the number of rooms at the end of the month.
- Bed capacity is assessed as the number of permanent beds existing at the end of each month. The possibility for extra beds is not included.
- Bed capacity utilization (occupied beds in relation to the bed capacity) is assessed as the number of nights stayed as percentage of the bed capacity, multiplied by the number of days in the month.
- Room capacity utilization (occupied beds in relation to the room capacity) is assessed as the number of rooms let out as a percentage of the room capacity, multiplied by the number of days in the month.

Note that small differences can occur in relation to similar statistics due to rounded off numbers or small adjustments.
