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This is a toolbox aimed at the different organisations and professionals working to promote Copenhagen internationally as UNESCO World Capital of Architecture in 2023. It is based on the national strategy "Copenhagen in Common", but with a bit more international outreach and a little less local insider-knowledge.

Its purpose is to streamline the upcoming communication to an extent where the target groups see this is a joint effort, despite the many different stakeholders involved and a variety of logos shown in the corner.

It opens with a manifest that explains the overall concept, followed by example executions for inspiration and finally more detailed guidelines for how to write headlines, body copy and ensure a consistent layout.

Manifest

In 2023, Copenhagen will become the World Capital of Architecture – with a special emphasis on the word "World".

Because even though we also celebrate Copenhagen's cultural heritage and architectural achievements, this is really not about us, but all of us. Copenhagen in 2023 will bring very different countries from very distant corners of the World together to show, discuss and improve all the things we have in common and where architecture plays an important part:

the homes we live in the neighbourhoods we engage in our daily commutes the public spaces the green oasis and the blue refreshments life between buildings and the need to prepare for a climate-changed future

We invite the World to join us in Copenhagen in a celebration of creativity and a democratic discussion on sustainable solutions to common challenges. Using the phrase "Copenhagen is for you" we target those with an interest in architecture – no matter if their main focus is its history and heritage, its potential to help nature or its ability to create everyday wonders.

Our core sentence is the inviting, open-arms statement "Copenhagen is for you".

But we narrow it down. Adding the small suffix "who", we can target people with specific values or interests. This allows us to outline a community of people with overlapping mindset.

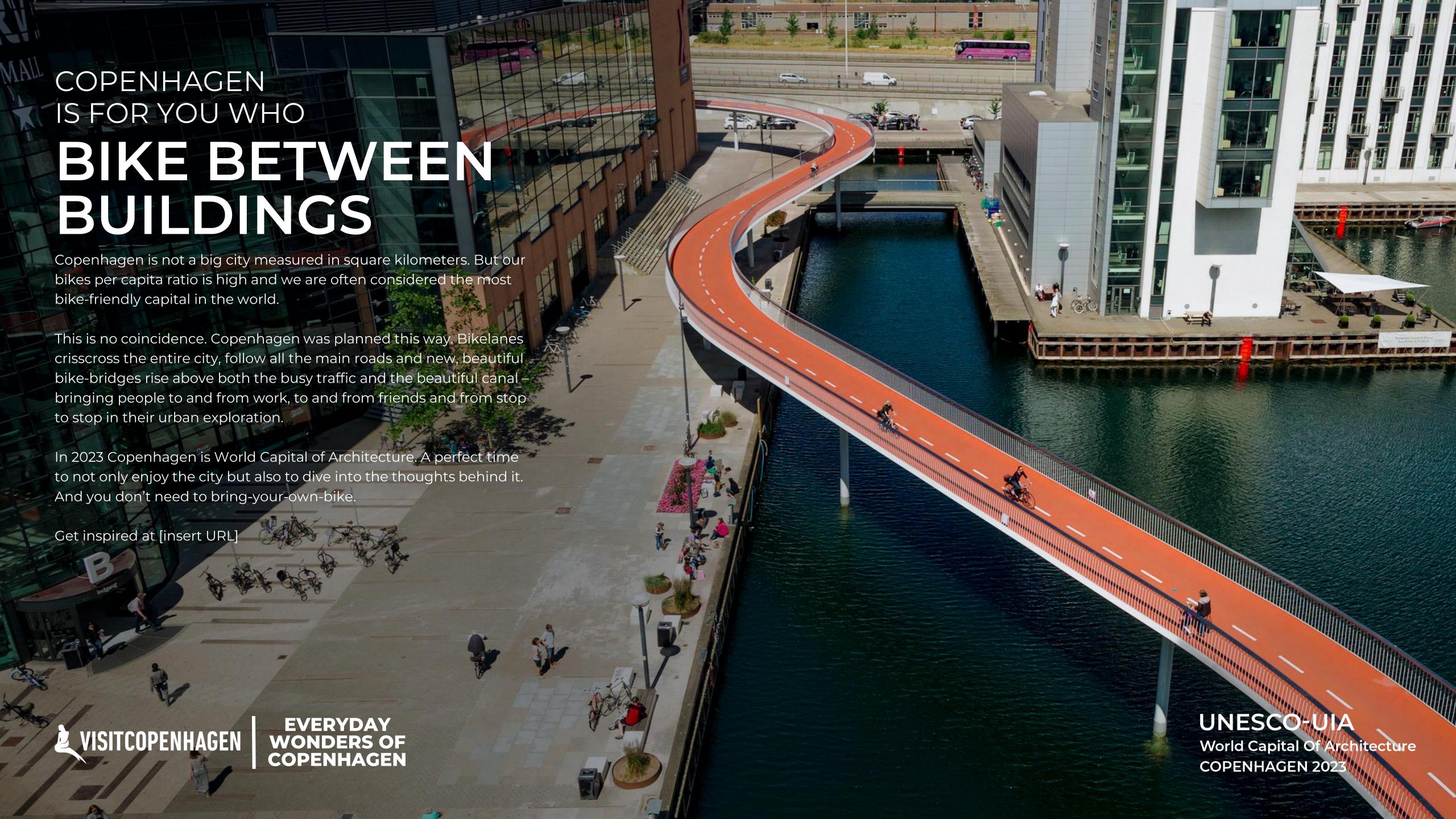

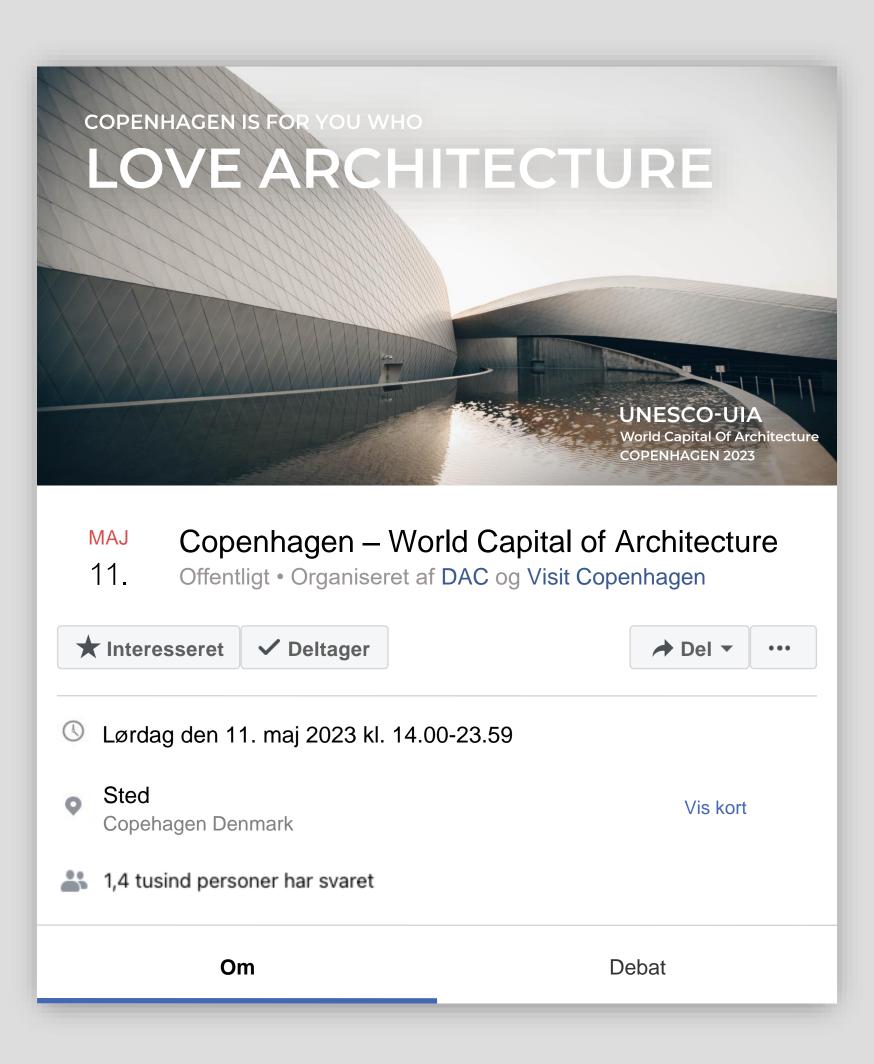




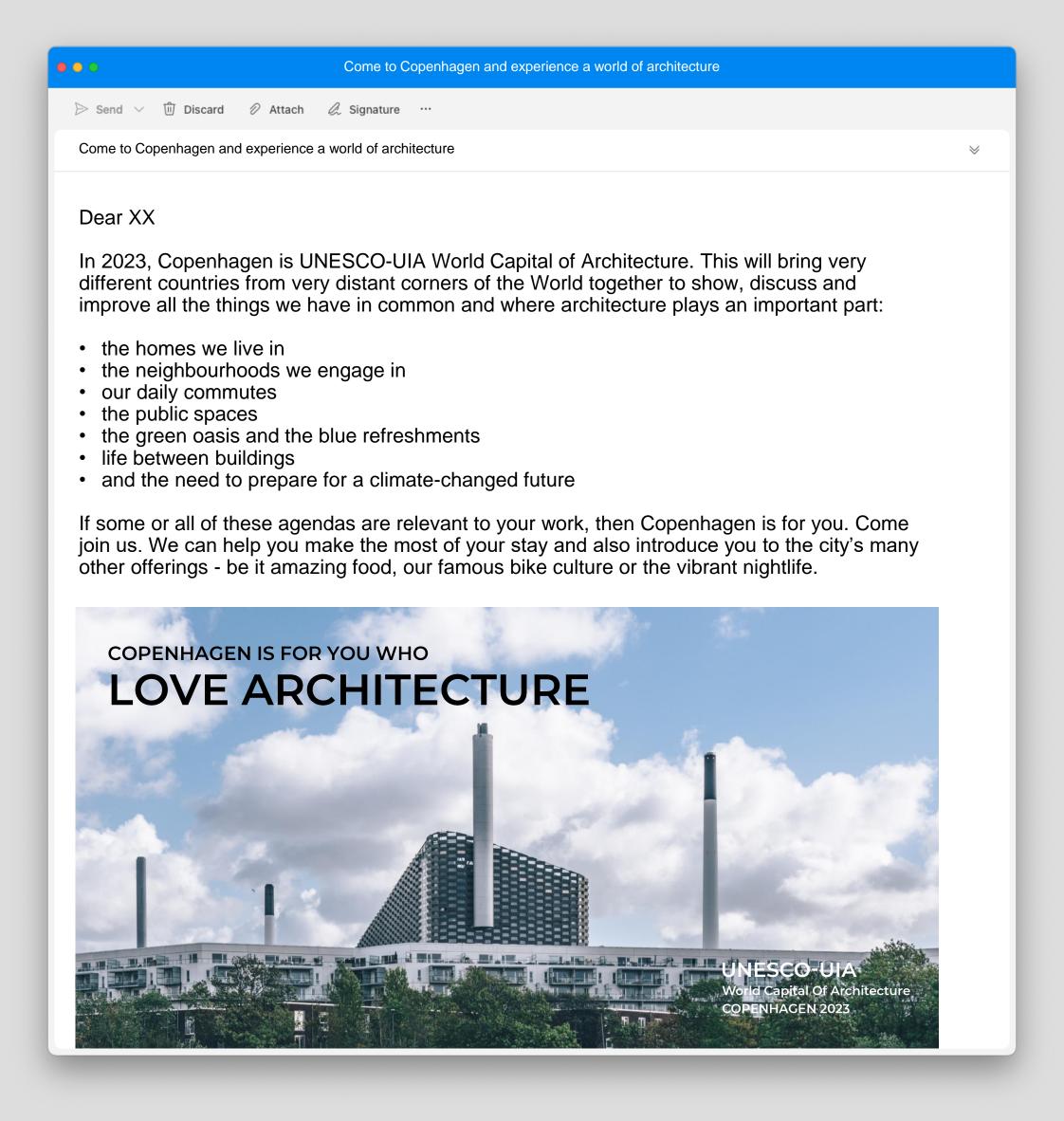
SoMe – The umbrella event

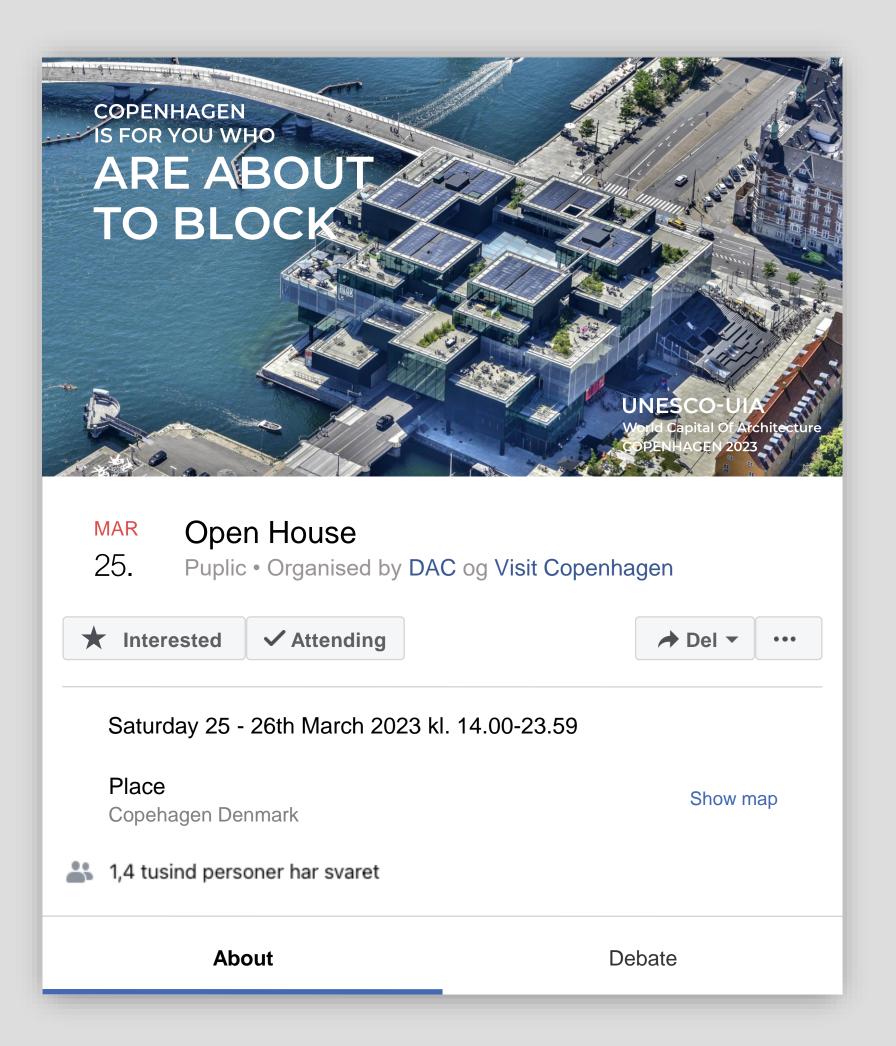

Guidelines

Writing "UNESCO-UIA World Capital of Architecture COPENHAGEN 2023" ads

The basis of this concept is a potential overlap between Copenhagen as a city and the reader as a person. For instance: Copenhagen has sustainability high on the agenda. If sustainability is high on your agenda too, dear reader, then you guys are a good match – Copenhagen is for you.

By addressing people with a relevant (in this case sustainable) mindset or professional experience directly, we indirectly describe Copenhagen as a city.

Examples in their simplest form: Copenhagen is for you who think green Copenhagen is for you who love sustainability

As the core sentence ("Copenhagen is for you") is already four words, the headlines will inevitably become quite long. Just embrace it and don't be afraid to play around with it:

Copenhagen is for you who is not afraid to think crazy (out loud)

COPENHAGEN IS FOR YOU WHO BIKE BETWEEN BUILDINGS

Copenhagen is not a big city measured in square kilometers. But our bikes per capita ratio is high and we are often considered the most bike-friendly capital in the world.

This is no coincidence. Copenhagen was planned this way. Bikelanes crisscross the entire city, follow all the main roads and new, beautiful bike-bridges rise above both the busy traffic and the beautiful canal bringing people to and from work, to and from friends and from stop to stop in their urban exploration.

In 2023 Copenhagen is World Capital of Architecture. A perfect time to not only enjoy the city but also to dive into the thoughts behind it. And you don't need to bring-your-own-bike.

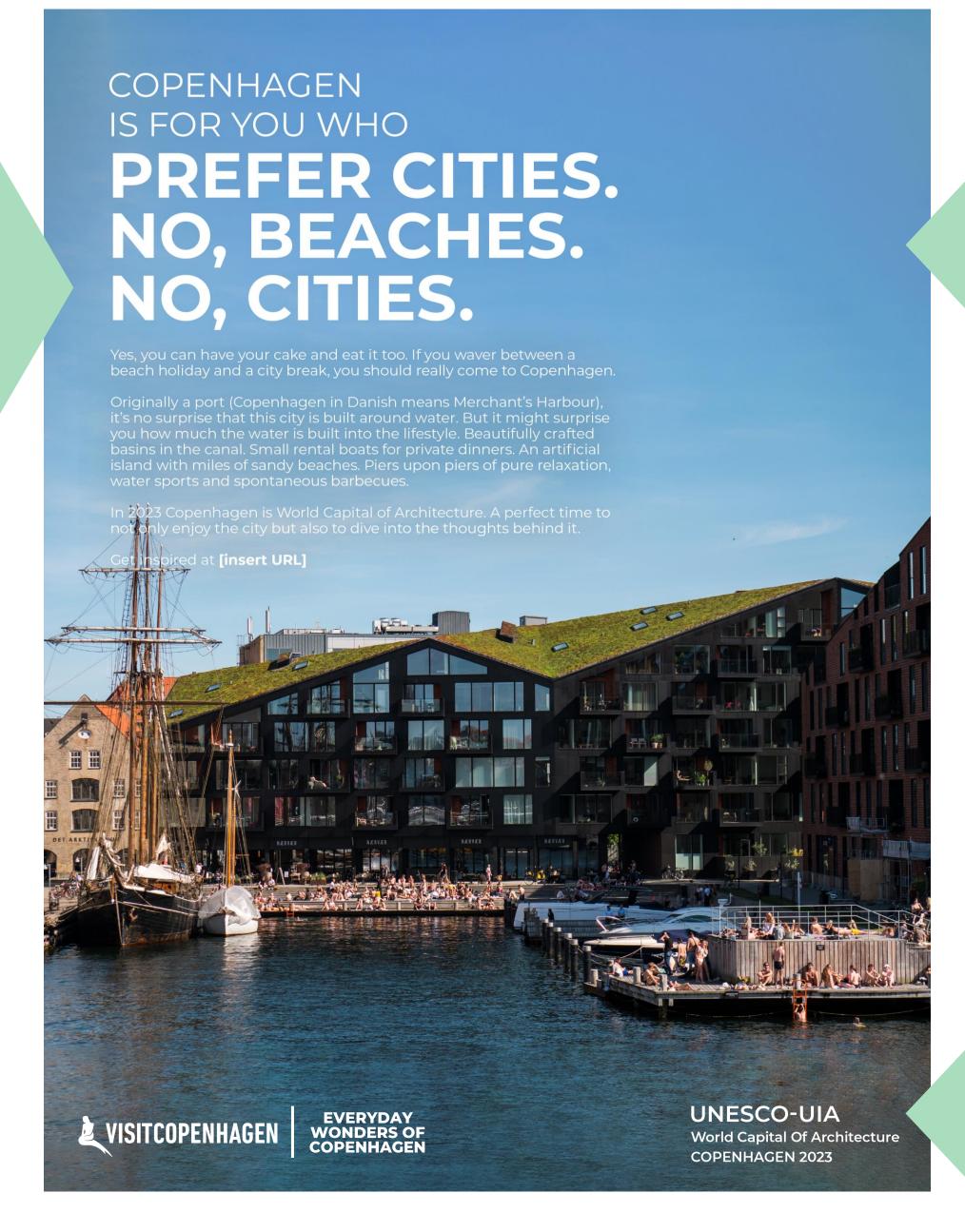

Headlines are always written in caps.

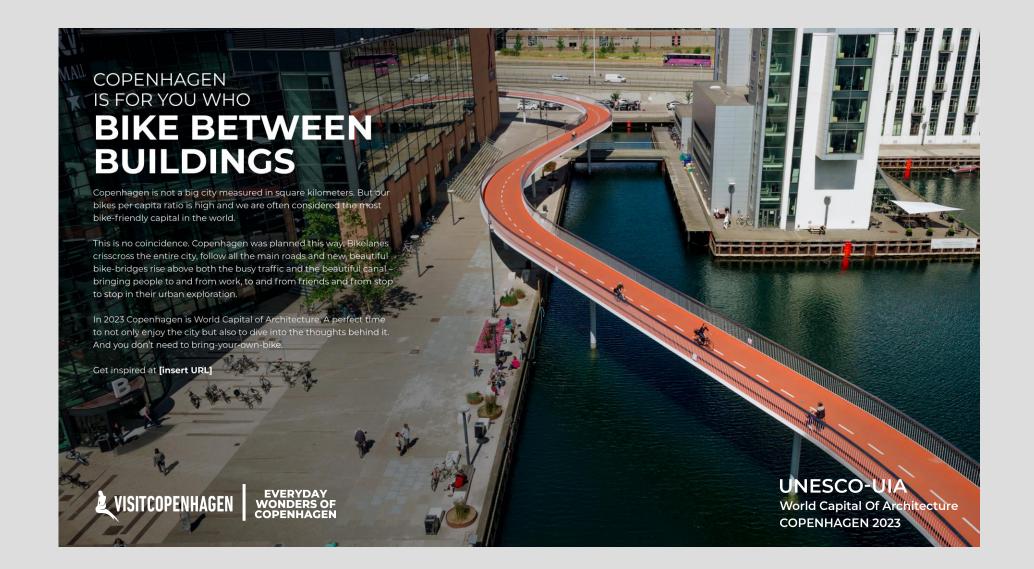

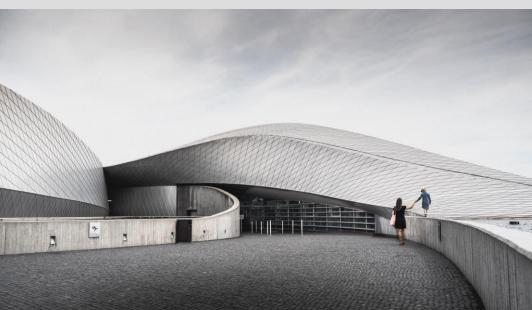


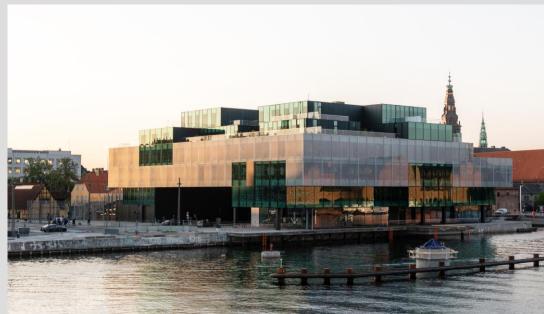
Visual guideline – Images

The image is full bleed and should showcase a unique location in Copenhagen promoting a piece of architecture that stands out and gets peoples attention. The photo should make people curious about the message. It is also a plus if the image has some sort of link to our sustainable agenda and the unique way we live in our capital (i.e. bikes). Having people in the photograph is a big plus.

The photo can be extended, and darkened or made lighter behind the text for better readability but should otherwise not have added additional effects.





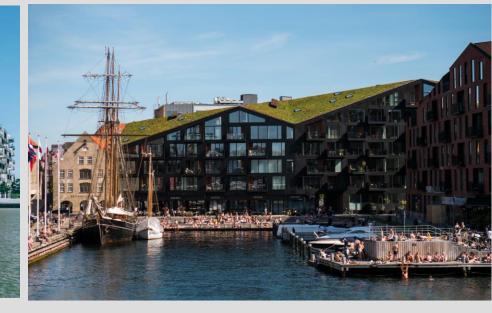
