WORLD NEWS MEDIA CONGRESS 2024

The day before the congress, 70 international students and 12 congress delegates participated in a full-day workshop to address one of the news industry's biggest challenges: Getting young people to read more news. The workshop resulted in 'The Copenhagen Criteria' (7 news values to guide news producers). The news values were presented in front of more than 200 news editors and journalists at the congress.

UIA WORLD CONGRESS OF ARCHITECTS 2023

As a result of a year long collaboration between numerous stakeholders, "The Copenhagen Lessons" (10 principles for a rapid and radical change in the built environment) were launched on the final day of the congress. The aim was to create a common language to accelerate sustainable change in the built environment, which is responsible for about 40% of annual CO2 emissions.
